Prof Dr Ong Teng Aik

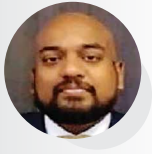
Dr TA Ong is currently the Vice President of the Malaysian Urological Association (MUA) and the Head of the Division of Urology, Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur. Dr TA Ong is actively involved in a number of Asian multi-centre collaborative research activities, including the South East Asia Think Tank Group on Lower Urinary Tract Symptoms and the A-Cap Asia Pacific Prostate Cancer Registry. Together with the clinical oncologists, Dr TA Ong set up the first Uro-Oncology Combined Clinic in the University of Malaya Medical Centre, Kuala Lumpur, in 2010. The clinic had since been the model of how urologists could work together with the oncologists to improve patient care. Dr TA Ong's current research focus areas in uro-oncology are prostate epidemiology in Asia, the challenges faced in managing patients with localized prostate cancer in an Asian country, especially in decision making.
